Millersville University Human Resources is offering training in how to use an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) and how to administer cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR). Whether you have been previously trained in AED/CPR, or would like to receive the training for the first time, you may sign up for either of the two classes:

Tuesday – August 22 from 12PM-4PM.

Both classes will be held at the SMC Reighard Multi-purpose Room.
