

Construction Now Scheduled to Begin Today on Central Manor Road Bridge Project in Manor Township

Lancaster County Bridge to be replaced as part of Public-Private Partnership

Construction for the Central Manor Road (State Route 3017) bridge, which spans West Branch of Little Conestoga Creek in Manor Township, Lancaster County is scheduled to begin today, July 10.

Construction is scheduled to run through September. During this time, drivers will be directed to follow a detour along Letort Road, George Street and Route 999.

In the event of unfavorable weather or unforeseen activities, this schedule may change (again).

This bridge is referred to as JV-282 and is one out of the 558 bridges being replaced under the Rapid Bridge Replacement Project. JV references the joint-venture partnership between Walsh/Granite, which is leading construction for the entire project.

The Rapid Bridge Replacement Project is a public-private partnership (P3) between PennDOT and Plenary Walsh Keystone Partners (PWKP), under which PWKP will finance, design, replace and maintain the bridges for 25 years. The P3 approach will allow PennDOT to replace the bridges more quickly while achieving significant savings and minimizing impact on motorists.
