The EARLY ALERT INITIATIVE allows all teaching faculty to identify students who are experiencing challenges in the classroom. These challenges can include: attendance, engagement, and difficulty with the course material.

If you are identified, you will receive an email entitled, “EARLY ALERT NOTICE”. You will be instructed to make contact directly with your professor, who made the referral, within the next two class meetings or as soon as possible. There can be many issues causing academic challenges such as time management, organization, academic preparedness, life issues, motivation, and/or adjustment stress. An EARLY ALERT CARE TEAM MEMBER will also follow up with you via email shortly after the notice. The email subject line will be “EARLY ALERT CHECK IN”.
