He has been an eyewitness to climate change, traveling tens of thousands of miles over 50 years, and leading teams on some of the most significant polar expeditions in history.

He is the founder of two nonprofits, the Will Steger Wilderness Center in Ely, MN which is dedicated to innovation and leadership in a wilderness setting; and Climate Generation: A Will Steger Legacy, headquartered in Minneapolis with a focus on engaging educators, youth and communities in solutions to climate change.
