Dr. Nancy Dennis is an Associate Professor of Psychology and Lab Director of The Cognitive Aging and Neuroimaging Lab at Penn State.

As an educator, researcher, and a woman in neuroscience, Dr. Dennis has over 19 years of research in cognitive aging and functional magnetic resonance imaging (fMRI).

Her work employs both behavioral and neuroimaging methods to explore the interaction of cognitive and neural processes involved in episodic memory, focusing on false memories. With respect to cognitive aging, her research concentrates on the examination of age-related neural markers of cognitive decline, as well as mechanisms for neural compensation.

Dr. Dennis’ work has been funded by the American Federation for Aging Research, the National Science Foundation, and the National Institute of Aging.
