**Re:** Boil Water Advisory

Millersville Borough has issued a public notice mandating the boiling of drinking water before consumption. For Millersville University, this advisory impacts the Student Memorial Center, Jefferson Hall and the houses used for programs and offices (Huntingdon House, Blair House, Mercer House, etc.). All other campus buildings are on the University water system which is not subject to the mandatory boiling water notice.

If you work or study in any of these buildings, avoid drinking the water unless it has been boiled. The water is safe to use for bathrooms, cleaning facilities, etc.

We will advise when the Borough lifts this requirement.
