I am pleased to announce the appointment of Dr. Kyle Verbosh as the Director of Institutional Research at Millersville University, effective May 12, 2017. Dr. Verbosh began serving as interim Director for Institutional Research in October 2016 after the retirement of Dr. Joseph Revelt. Kyle joined Millersville in July 2016 as the Assistant Director, Institutional Research.

Prior to his arrival at Millersville, Kyle Verbosh was an Institutional Researcher in the Department of Research & Institutional Effectiveness as Johnston Community College in Smithfield, North Carolina. He served as a Research Associate at the National Initiative for Leadership and Institutional Effectiveness (NILIE) at North Carolina State University. Preceding his transition into the institutional research field in higher education, Dr. Verbosh was a high school Mathematics teacher in North Carolina. Dr. Verbosh received in Doctor of Philosophy in Educational Research and Policy Analysis / Higher Education from North Carolina State University and his Master of Education in Student Affairs Administration from Clemson University. He earned a Bachelor's degree in Secondary Education, Mathematics, from The Pennsylvania State University.
