Re: Appointment of the new Director for Visual and Performing Arts

After a nationwide search, it is with great pleasure that I announce that Ms. Robin D. Zaremski will be our new permanent Director of Visual and Performing Arts Centers at Millersville University starting on January 6, 2018.

Robin has a Bachelor of Arts from West Chester University, a Certificate in Recording Arts and Sciences from UCLA, and Juris Doctorate from Temple University. Robin has been working in the music business since the early 1990s, first working at the Screen Actors Guild as their singers' representative. She has also worked for Almo Sounds/Rodor Music – the record company and music publisher owned by Herb Alpert and Jerry Moss of A & M. She then became the Director of Programming for Musikfest (what is now ArtsQuest) booking artists for both the festival and the Main Stage. She also worked at Universal Music in New York.

She began her teaching career in music business at Albright College. She taught over eleven unique music business courses. She returned to ArtsQuest to help them open SteelStacks and then accepted the position as Director of Kutztown University Presents. She is married to Mark Thompson and has a daughter, Anna, who is a freshman in college.

Robin has served on the board for PA Presenters, and was recently voted in as President of the organization. Robin is a member of the national organization the Association of Performing Arts Professionals and is well known and respected with our peers in the field.
