TUE SEP 04	Last day to submit a request to take a course on a pass/fail or audit basis (requests must be in the Registrar's Office by 4:30pm)
WED SEP 05	W grade period begins
MON SEP 17	Winter web schedule & other registration information available online
THU SEP 27	Application deadline for Fall degree (applications must be filed in the Registrar's Office by 4:30pm) Applications for the master's degree (graduation) must be filed with Graduate Studies & Adult Learning.
FRI SEP 28	Deadline to change/add a major or minor in time for Spring 2019 advisement. Any changes in major or minor submitted to the Registrar's office after this date will be processed, but TAP number and advisement will be done with the student's advisor as of this date.

M ***TAP Numbers available October 8th!***

If you are a currently registered undergraduate student and will be looking to register for Spring 2019 classes, you will NEED to obtain your TAP number from your academic adviser in order to register for Spring! Be sure to schedule an appointment to meet with your adviser on or after October 8th to obtain advisement and to get your TAP number *before* your appointment time in November (the registration appointment schedule will be available October 3rd)!

M ***Transfer Credit for Summer Courses:***

If you had approval to take courses at another college this summer, have an official transcript sent to the Registrar's Office so the credits can be recorded on your MU record. Note that an [Authorization for the Transfer of Credit](#) form MUST be completed before you take a course at another institution.
