Chancellor to Visit Millersville University

Dr. Daniel (Dan) Greenstein, the new Chancellor of the Pennsylvania State System of Higher Education (PASSHE), will be at Millersville University on Tuesday, September 18.

Dr. Greenstein began his journey as Chancellor earlier this month. He is starting his tour of all 14 universities in the State System with Millersville University. He wants to hear from everyone – students, alumni, faculty, staff and others. "I want to hear your stories, listen to your ideas and understand the challenges and obstacles that we face—that you face," says Greenstein. "I want to know what makes us good, to know about the issues that keep us from becoming better, and to know how we can address those issues."
