² All University operations, except University Police services and other designated services, will be suspended on Friday, November 29, 2019. It is not an official holiday except for those people covered under the AFSCME bargaining unit. All other staff are encouraged to apply for annual or personal leave in lieu of reporting to work on that day. Employees requesting annual or personal leave must submit a request through ESS or submit a Request for Leave form to their supervisor by November 8, 2019.

- ³ All University operations, except University Police services and other designated services, will be suspended on Thursday, December 26, 2019. All other staff are encouraged to apply for annual or personal leave in lieu of reporting to work on that day. Employees requesting annual or personal leave must submit a request through ESS or submit a Request for Leave form to their supervisor by December 6, 2019.
- ⁴ These days account for the three deferred holidays: Presidents' Day (Monday, February 18, 2019), Columbus Day (Monday, October 14, 2019), and Veterans Day observed (Monday, November 11, 2019).
