In late October, we alerted the campus to three hate crimes involving racial and anti-Semitic graffiti discovered in men's bathrooms on campus.

Since that time, the graffiti has been removed and police have been investigating all three incidents. While no arrests have been made at this time, I am encouraged that no other incidents have been reported.

In the aftermath of those incidents, I met with various campus and student leaders to encourage an open dialogue. Those conversations will continue.

This is a good time to remind everyone that our community at Millersville University condemns all forms of hate, bigotry and discrimination. We are united in our stand against hate. Any form of intolerance or hate are antithetical to our EPPIC values and our mission.

Please remain vigilant and help us by promptly reporting any incidents to the campus police by calling 717-871-4357 or report anonymously through the LiveSafe app.

As we enter the final stretch of the semester, please look out for each other and be kind to each other.
