WCU teacher invents voice-evaluation app

As vocal athletes, teachers are experiencing debilitating voice disorders that are prompting significant health concerns in the U.S. Speech-language pathologist Dr. Liz Grillo, professor of communication sciences and disorders in the College of Health Sciences at West Chester University, has been studying the phenomena for decades, and has invented the only comprehensive voice-evaluation smartphone application (app) tool in the U.S. that allows individuals to quickly assess voice measure changes on a daily basis and while teachers are actually teaching.
