

STUDENT PARKING REGISTRATION IS OPEN

REGISTER FOR A PERMIT ONLINE

Registration is easy. Just log into your MAX account, click on student services, then click on student parking permit requests link at the bottom of the page. Remember to have your vehicle information ready when applying.

Permits are issued based on your status as a commuting or residential (dorm) student. You will only be able to apply for a permit based on your status.

Please read ALL instructions and information BEFORE you click and apply for a parking permit. If your status is not correct, please contact the Housing or Admissions Office or stop by the Parking Office in Lebanon House for assistance.

We also remind all students to consider using the campus shuttle and RRTA bus as an option with parking and walking to class.

Welcome back students!

Below is some information that you might find useful if you wish to park a vehicle on campus

Commuter parking:

The Eastside Parking Garage (Pucillo Drive) will be closed this school year due to the renovations at Penn Manor High School.

Frederick Street will be reopened by the start of the semester with additional street parking, up to 80 vehicles spaces. This parking will be limited to day and evening hours only, with no overnight parking from 2am – 6am.

Additional commuter parking has been added to the James Street parking areas across from the tennis courts.

Just remember, parking is always available in the parking lots on the outskirts of campus. If you are looking for available commuter parking, try parking in the Ann Street lot (toward Wellness) or the South SMC lot (behind Marauder Courts). Both parking lots are located off Shenks Lane. The Westside Parking Garage (Prince St & Cottage Ave by the baseball field) also has available parking during peak hours.

Resident (dorm) parking:

Parking for resident (dorm) students is located outside of East and West Villages and the South Suites. Additional parking is located next to the ATM on Centennial Drive.

Additionally, residential students with permits will be able to park in the Westside Parking Garage (Prince St & Cottage Ave by the baseball field). This will assist resident students returning from field assignments and classes at the Ware Center.

Restricted / Overflow parking:

For commuters wishing to save money, a reduced-price permit is available. This permit will allow you to park in the Westside Parking Garage (Prince St & Cottage Ave) only. Students using this permit often utilize the free campus shuttle.
