Gates and Dreon piloted several successful faculty mentoring initiatives in support of pre-tenure faculty last year.

Supported by the CAE Faculty Fellowship program, the Faculty Mentoring Program will work directly with the director of the CAE to coordinate programming, and programming needs. Drs. Gates and Dreon will serve as CAE Faculty Fellows for a two-year term. As part of their fellowship project, Drs.
