There are currently more jobs available for K-12 Technology & Engineering Education (TECE) teachers than there are teachers to fill them. This minor was designed to help undergraduate education majors to prepare to be TECE teachers. Graduates with certifications in other areas (e.g., science, math, social studies, English, early childhood education) could apply for certification in Technology Education in Pennsylvania, and many other states as well.

In this minor, students acquire some background to deliver courses in Technology & Engineering Education, particularly at the K-8 level as these courses tend to be broad-based survey types of courses or experiences. Most classes are hands-on, experiential learning courses.
